

TUITION FEES AND OTHER CHARGES | 2027/28

Tuition fees are revised annually. Increases are normally between 2% and 7% and are applied to students in all years of study, including those continuing.

* Tuition fees for UK undergraduate students on the BMus programme are aligned with the maximum tuition fee cap set by the UK government and may increase in line with CPI. This means that the full-time and part-time Home BMus fees may increase for BMus students in all years of study.
